MATH WEBSITES

www.education.com

- A free website for students 2-11 years. They can play math or ELA games. Parents can download worksheets or workbooks. There is a fee based option that allows you to track your child's progress.

www.abcy.com

- Web based games for students in Pre-K through 5th grade. The site offers math and ELA games for students to practice their skills.

www.prodigygame.com

- [Prodigy](http://www.prodigygame.com) is a free, adaptive math game for grades 1-7 that integrates Common Core into a role-playing game using a Pokemon-style wizardry theme. Based on the preliminary tutorial, students are placed at a math level. As they play, question difficulty is increased or decreased depending upon their answers.



MATH APPS



- **Teaching Number Lines by Little Monkey:** Introduces the concept of number lines to young students. The app helps students visualize numbers for rote counting and ordering and to see the physical position of a number linking patterns and relationships. The company also has apps for place value, money, addition, and subtraction. Ages 4+
- **Counting Caterpillar:** Teaches the basics of counting by ones and then increases to the concepts of skip counting by 2, 5, and 10. Ages 3-6
- **Math Learning Center** Offers 10 free apps, including number frames, math vocabulary cards, number lines, and shapes. Ages 3-12

MATH APPS

- **Splash Math** Topics cover addition, subtraction, geometry, time, money, and more. Ages 5-10
- **Reflex Math** Focus is on math fluency and being able to recall math facts from memory quickly. Age 7-12
- **Math Slide** A program that offers four different math apps that focus on place value and basic math facts. Each app has 10 different games. Ages 6-12
- **Cloud Math** A fun learning tool for students from kindergarten through elementary. With choices of avatars, great sounds and animation, easy to control levels of difficulty and operations - practicing math is easy and fun.

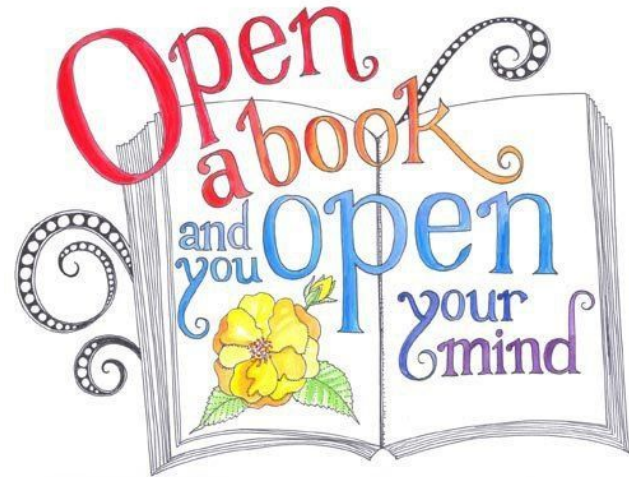

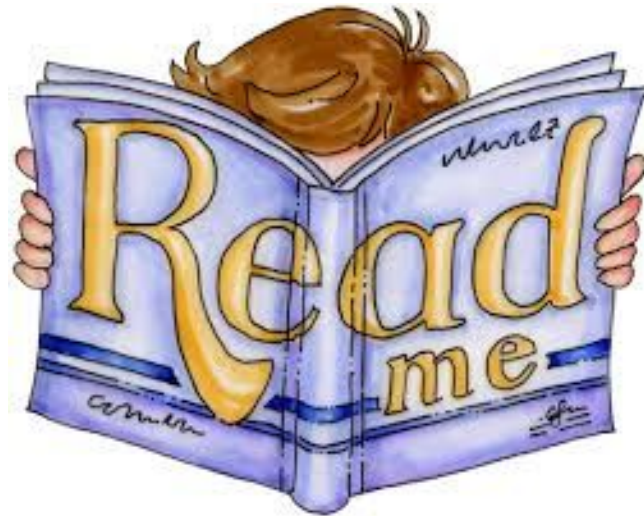
